

Q1. If a graph has 5 vertices and 7 edges, what is the maximum number of edges in a simple undirected graph?

- A. 10
- B. 12
- C. 15
- D. 20

Solution: In a simple undirected graph, the maximum number of edges is given by the formula $V(V-1)/2$. For 5 vertices, it is $5(5-1)/2 = 10$.
